

USES OF NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH ACT (NSLA) FUNDS

2013-2014, 2014-2015 and 2015-16

National School Lunch Act (NSLA) Funds are used to:

- Purchase and maintain technology software, materials, supplies and equipment
- Hire and train personnel to support curriculum development, classroom instruction, data-based decision-making, technology integration, etc.
- Provide a district nurse to support safety and wellness of students
- Offer a Pre-Kindergarten program for 3- and 4-year-old children
- Provide supplemental instruction and coordination of services for students who are English learners
- Hire highly-qualified tutors to provide supplemental instruction during the school day
- Provide early intervention services
- Hire human services personnel to assist with parental involvement, safety, attendance, and academic achievement of students
- Provide instructional materials to improve student learning in literacy and math
- Support alternative education services (SUCCESS)
- Contract with the Jonesboro Police Department to provide School Resource Officers (SROs) in elementary and secondary schools
